This letter concerns the unauthorized discharge of fill material into a waters of the United States on property that you own. The subject property is located at 54-183 Hauula Homestead Road, Tax Map Key (TMK) Number 1-5-4-007:006, 21.6070°, -157.9125°, Hauula, Honolulu County, Oahu, Hawaii.

We required that certain restoration be completed in order to resolve the violation. Our October 5, 2018 site inspection confirmed the required restoration has been completed to our satisfaction. Therefore, the violation is resolved.

If your future plans involve work in or affecting navigable waters of the United States, or the placement of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States, including jurisdictional wetlands, you must apply for, and receive, a Department of the Army permit prior to beginning the work.

Nothing in this letter excuses you from compliance with other Federal, State, or local statutes, ordinances, or regulations. For informational purposes, a copy of this letter is being sent to the agencies on the enclosed list.
